Position overview

The role of this position is to provide overall IT support to the National Office. In addition, contribute to the development of standard operating procedures and forms for ICT and ensure that they are consistently applied.

Roles and responsibilities:

- 1. Support in management and maintenance of TFU ICT infrastructure including LANs and WANs, Wi-Fi, networks, computers, laptops and servers across the organization.
- 2. Provide support in the design of an effective ICT for the organization following trends in the industry.
- 3. Providing desktop hardware/software, IDs and passwords to business applications.
- 4. Ensure compliance and adherence to ICT policies and procedures.
- 5. Execute the operational plans for the ICT systems and manage inventory of all assets.
- 6. Ensure user access to applications and systems and resolve network failures in a timely manner.
- 7. Provide first level support to users for IT related problems, record all incidents and follow them up to resolution.
- 8. Review applications in conjunction with users to determine enhancements or new systems.
- Monitor the services provided by external suppliers in liaison with the Operation Coordinator to ensure that high levels of service are received and maintained as per agreed standards.
- 10. Manage the formalized training program for all users with the aim of raising skills standards and awareness in the use of ICT applications.



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- 11. Prepare periodic reports in line with the organization's reporting guidelines to management.
- 12. Any other duties assigned from time to time.
